General Business:

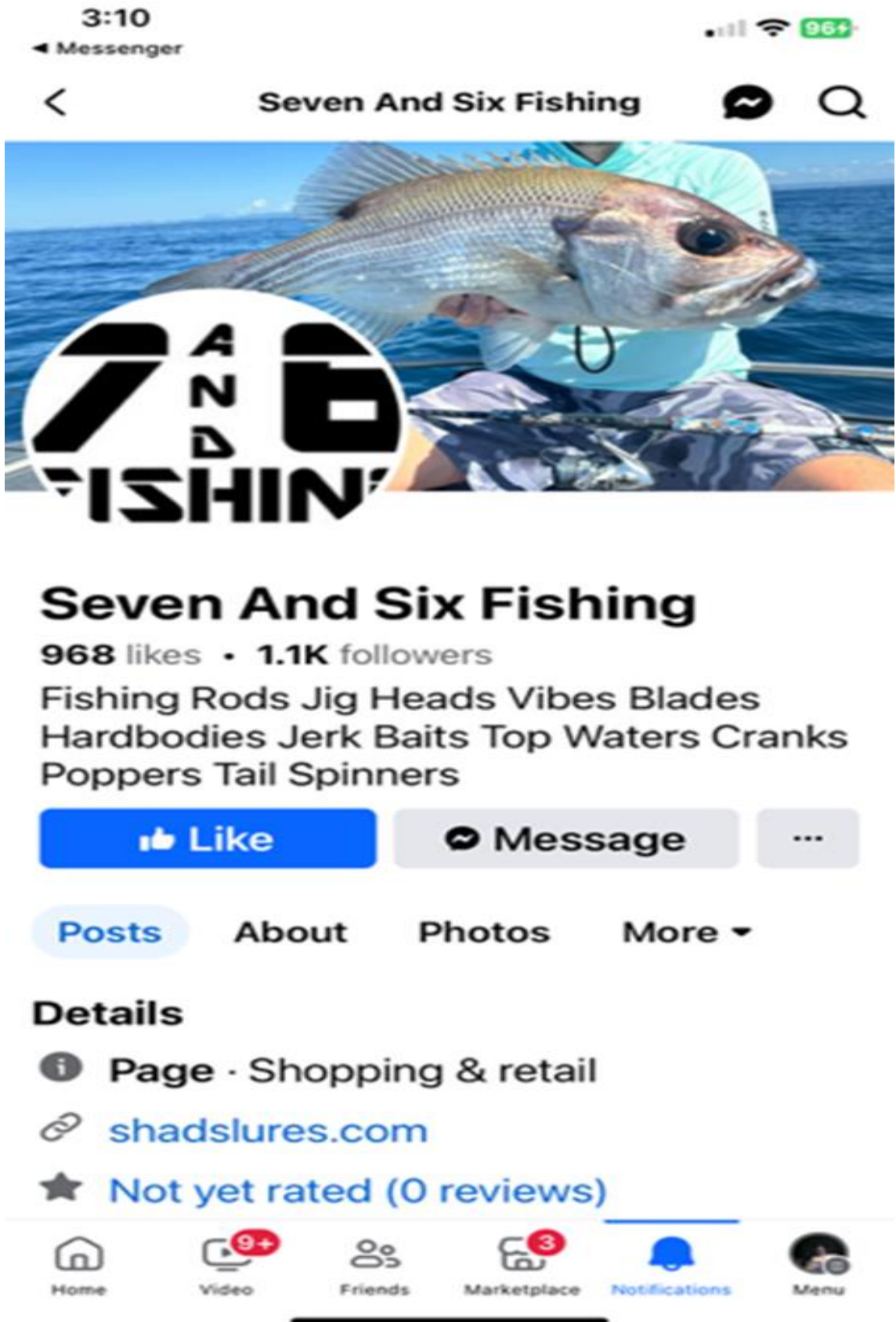
- Ralph asked where we are with the Shelter over the Grassed area. The MBBC has approved our plans and we are pursuing quotes.

RECORDER REPORT - JULY

Hi members,

It is a new fishing year, so good luck to everybody and I hope you all catch plenty of fish and give the recorder plenty of work.

I will be putting my hand up at the AGM to be recorder again for the next year, now that I have the hang of it. Sort of haha.

If you need to know how points are allocated for your submitted captures throughout the year, the fishing rules are on the RPGSC website. This is where you find weight points formulas and tag points.

Please remember that members can weigh their fish themselves outside of club weekends. You will need to have your scales checked out by the weighmaster for accuracy. You can get this do at the club weigh-in each month. Complete a capture sheet and send it to the recorder along with pictures. If the fish is a record, you will need to weigh it on official registered scales.

I know the rules and paperwork can be boring and time consuming, but it needs to be fair for the fishos that are competing by the rules and line classes.

Note to all – If you are not fishing to the correct ANSA or QGFA regulations every time head out fishing, you run the risk of catching a National or QLD Record size fish and not been able to claim it.

We now have a Capture sheet to the website. This would be useful for members don't have access to an official capture book available. You will find it a www.rpgfc.com.au under the Club points tab. Take the time to learn and understand the rules before you hit the water.

Shovelnose Rays – Remember, they have a legal maximum length of 1.5 metres or interdoresal length is 60cm. They are on our eligible species list.

Our club caters for everyone, you can be a record or trophy hunter or a social fisher. Its up to you. If you need any help with the rules, as me or send me a message. Either way, make sure you look after your catch. If you are returning it to the water, support the fish, keep it wet and off the hot floor. If you are eating it, bleed it and get it on ice.
