The seas were not too bad over this period with a few of us still trying to score some more marlin and choice species.



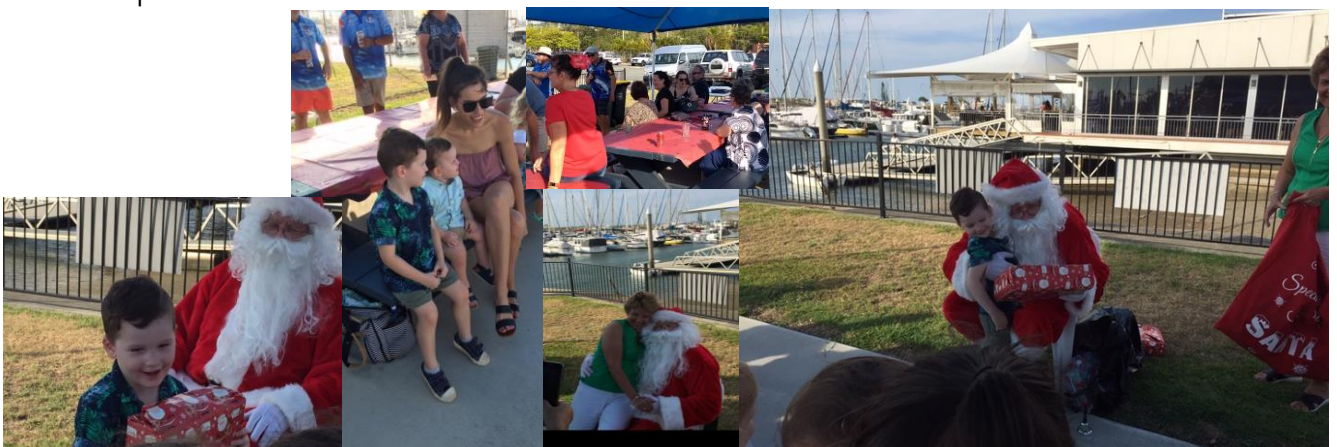

New Year, Waiheke NZ Charter

Your Tacklebox editor got away to NZ for the Xmas break and joined three friends for an all girls fishing charter off Waiheke Island.

Our skipper Leon from On the Hunt Charters had an easy day with four no nonsense fisherwoman on board his 2018 Surtees 750 Gamefisher vessel.



The weather was average so we travelled no more than 10 minutes from the Matiaitia Wharf, anchoring in a strong out going current but with the boat facing into the wind it wasn't too uncomfortable – and there we stayed for the length of our charter, pulling in snapper after snapper. Mary got her PB at 6kg, Fi another around 4kg and Jo and I with plenty of 35cm ish fish (legal limit in NZ is 30cm). We also pulled in plenty in the 27-28cm range which went back but give a good indication of the health of the fishery.

We kept 8 for eating and Leon kindly filleted them for us – feeding the skins to the local bronze whalers - we only had one tiddler of 7 ft or so come up to the boat, apparently they are all too well fed! The fish frames went to locals for stock making and crab bait. Nothing wasted. Highly recommend it!
