



To win the money for the monthly nominated fish inshore or offshore species, simply weigh in the heaviest **Mackerel Tuna** or **Bream**. All fish weighed, regardless of whether they are in for the 'fish of the month' must be labelled with the angler's name and line class. To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded at the following club night. Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on Friday **15th March** finishing on **Sunday 17th March** at 3.30-4.30pm.

#### March 2019



Your Tacklebox editor has just returned from time away in Rarotonga in the Cook Islands.

We chartered the Wahoo for a mornings heavy tackle fishing – dropping the lures the minute we left harbour into nearly 800m of water. A dull first hour and then bang – hooked up to a large blue marlin on a flying fish dead bait (fish estimated by the deckie at 120 - 150kgs).

No tagging or IGFA rules here – the skipper wanted the fish in the boat however after some initial spectacular jumps it appears it had spat the hook but then we'd foul hooked it. Two and a half hours later, and with everyone taking a turn, we'd had the fish to the boat twice, along with two free swimming mates of his! We just couldn't get any purchase on it and it would swim away again – eventually on full lock it predictably broke the line.

Anglers may compete in one or more challenges. Each individual fish can only be submitted in one challenge.

BEACH Challenge (land based) – Fish must be caught from a land based position such as a jetty, wharf, beach or bank. A combined total length of your best 5 fish.

BAY Challenge (bay, lakes & rivers) – Fish must be caught in any of the Bays, estuary's, canals, lakes and rivers. A combined total length of best 5 fish.

BLUEWATER Challenge (offshore) – Fish must be caught offshore as per the fishing areas. A combined total length of best 5 fish.
