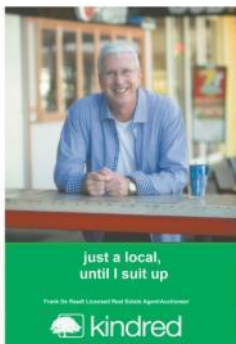

Q.G.F.A NEWS

1 May 2018

The QGFA Executive has received a request from the Gold Coast GFC and the Surfers Paradise G&SFC for us to put out a Notice of Motion to Postal Vote because they would like to have this matter settled before the new fishing year of 1st July 2018.

Whilst the motion only affects the two southern Zones 3 & 4 the vote has to come from the full Council (All Member Clubs).

The motion being put forward, was moved by the Gold Coast GFC and Seconded by the Surfers Paradise GFC and is as follows;

“That the depth rule for the use of heavy tackle, in Zones 3 and 4 only, be increased from 100 meters to 150 meters for QGFA All Ports and QGFA Overall Point scoring.”

For the benefit of clubs in Zones 3 & 4, the points will not change for heavy tackle use, but if you fish heavy tackle (15kg to 60kg) in under 150 meters of water you will not be eligible to score points for QGFA Trophies.

The Rationale behind the amendment states:

“The rationale for this amendment is to keep the competition between Zone 3 & 4 as fair as possible in the ethics of our sport. There is a different demographical area between Zone 3 & 4 where in Zone 3 there are Black Marlin holding in just over 100m of water which when caught on 15kg line are able to receive double the points (with the current QGFA rule structures), versus the Zone 4 area where Black Marlin are holding in 100m and can only be caught on 8kg line. This disadvantages the Zone 4 Clubs as they can only receive half points in comparison to the fish caught on 15kg in over 100m of water.”


RE: AMENDMENT - QGFA POINT SCORE & ALL PORTS DEPTH RULE

The Gold Coast Game Fish Club Inc. would like to put forward a Notice of Motion to the QGFA Executives to amend the Heavy Tackle depth rule for Zones 3 & 4 in the QGFA Point Score & the QGFA All Ports Interclub Championships from 100m to 150m and have this sent to a postal vote in order for it to be finalised before the 1st July 2018.

The rationale for this amendment is to keep the competition between Zone 3 & 4 as fair as possible in the ethics of our sport. There is a different demographical area between Zone 3 & 4 where in Zone 3 there are Black Marlin holding in just over 100m of water which when caught on 15kg line are able to receive double the points (with the current QGFA rule structures) versus the Zone 4 area where Black Marlin are holding in under 100m and can only be caught on 8kg line. This disadvantages the Zone 4 Clubs as they can only receive half points in comparison to the fish caught on 15kg in over 100m of water.

We have full support of all four (4) Clubs in Zone 4 to see this Motion implemented by the QGFA. The Surfers Paradise Game & Sport Fishing Club would like to second our motion. Please kindly find signatures below in support of this Motion from both the GCGFC Inc. & SPGSFC respectively.

Fishing Area: All waters between Double Island point and Qld/NSW Border including freshwater dams and rivers excluding privately owned waters.

Who Can Fish: The competition is open anyone who is a financial member of ANSA or QGFA, and registers for the competition with competition organisers prior to start fishing.

Weigh Station will be Open: 3.30pm to 4.30 pm Saturday and 3.30pm to 4.30pm Sunday.

Fishing Times: Midnight Friday and fishing will cease at 3.30 pm Sunday, no overtime on Sunday.

Eligible Species: Only fish species as per species list.

Line Classes: you may use line classes – 1kg, 2kg, 3kg, 4kg, 6kg, 8kg, 10kg, and 15kg.

Gilled & Gutted Fish: A 10% allowance will be given for cleaned fish, but no allowance will be made for Masters, State or National records.

Fishing Rules: This competition is conducted under ANSA rules for Division 1 Sportfishing and Division 2 Lure casting. All State and Federal Fishing Regulations and bag limits must be observed.

What Can You Weigh: Each Angler can weigh up to a maximum of 5 fish of each species per day (within fishing regulations).

How are Points calculated: Capture points are calculated as per the ANSA formula. (Fish weight kg) x 100 x fighting factor and then divided by line class = points. Catch and Release points as per the table.

Fish Identification: Please ensure all fish presented to the weigh master are labelled with the angler's initials, line class and division.

fishing with "breakaway trace". The breakaway trace must be a minimum of 500mm long and a maximum 1000mm in length. The main line must be at least one strain heavier than the breakaway trace

BBQ: There will be a free BBQ provided on Sunday for the weigh-in and presentation. Alcoholic beverages may be purchased from the MBBC can bar.

The factor shall be taken from the list of Eligible Species.

Weigh in

Weigh-in will be conducted on the grassed area under the shade sail next to the MBBC boat ramp. Full MBBC members use the club boat ramp and pontoon any time as per usual. Social members and non MBBC members must launch at public boat ramps. Competitors may also access weigh-in area via the side gate next to the main entrance.

Competition organisers reserves the right at any stage of the tournament to disqualify or deduct points from individuals who are deemed to have conducted themselves in a disrespectful manner and are deemed to have brought the sport of Sportfishing or the RPG&GC Inc. or the Moreton Bay Boat Club (MBBC) into disrepute. MBBC licensing regulations must be observed including appropriate dress codes and alcohol restrictions.

Guiding Information: Combination Main line and Breakaway line.

Breakaway Line must be (min 0.5M – max 1.0M). Main line must be at least 1 class heavier than the Breakaway trace. The use of a double/ leader/ trace is optional. When a breakaway line is used in conjunction with a main line the entire combined line will be accepted by ANSA at the breaking strain of the breakaway line for all Divisions and Records (Line Class) and Masters Awards. Existing criteria for the combined length of doubles, leaders and traces will be as per ANSA Rule Book.

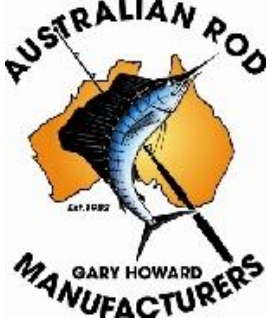
Main Line Knot/swivel Breakaway Line Knot/swivel Double/ leader/trace



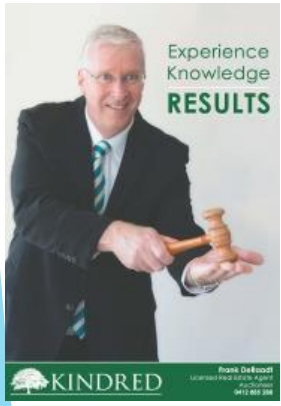
