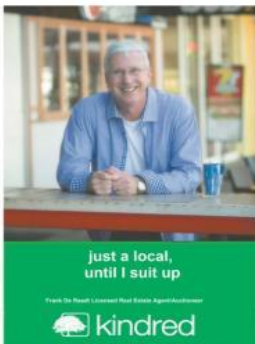

NZ Snapper at Great Barrier Island



Your Tacklebox editor managed to sneak away to NZ for the Xmas break and had an excellent few days with family on Great Barrier Island – the island is 4 hours by ferry from Auckland or 30 minutes by light plane.

I took the 12 seater Cessna Caravan option and very much regretted it! The first two attempts at landing on the grass strip at Claris were aborted due to cross winds but we made it in on the third attempt – clapping all round! You can just see the airfield in the photo above.

It was too windy on the first few days to get out but when we did it was only 400 metres from the boat ramp and then a drift back to base, snapper on the bite within moments of dropping our baits. Preference was for a plastic lure with added squid. A lot of fish in the 27 – 28 cm range with the minimum in NZ being 30 cm. We picked up a good feed before I switched to pilchards and hooked up to a 1.3m bronze whaler shark, which I swore was a big snapper right up until I saw him appear! Alas I had to head back to the mainland and wasn't around for the crayfish caught in the pots on the subsequent snapper fish frames.

I can highly recommend Great Barrier island to anyone seeking a great fishing escape. There are plenty of options on the island including 1* to 5* accommodation.

All fish weighed, regardless of whether they are in for the 'fish of the month' must be labelled with the angler's name and line class. To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded at the BBQ on Sunday.

Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on **Friday 18th January**, finishing on **Sunday 20th December** with a weigh-in and barbeque at 3.30-4.30pm. This month's species are **Yellowfin Tuna** and **Dart**.
