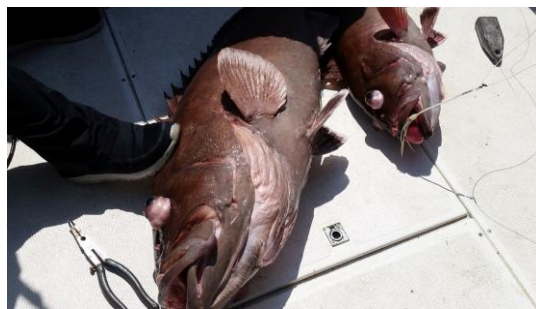

While many fished offshore, we fished the Burnett River. We caught Flatheads, Grunter, Breams, not so Giant Trevally and Gold Spot Cod. Also caught a heap of big Green Toads which were in plague proportions and ate every bait and lure they could find. Best fish was Vaughn's 760mm Flathead caught and released.

On the Saturday night, all the yearly ANSA award winners were announced.

Sunday afternoon was also the AGM. Nathan Johnston was re-elected as president, Adam Royle as vice-president, Andrew Doherty is going around again as treasurer and Mick King elected as Convenor. So our club is well represented at ANSA Qld level. The 2019 AGM will be hosted by Sunshine Coast Sportfishing Club.

We thought so! All you need to do is catch a fish with a pink ANSA QLD tag, collect some details, take a photo and enter it into the ANSA online recapture form.

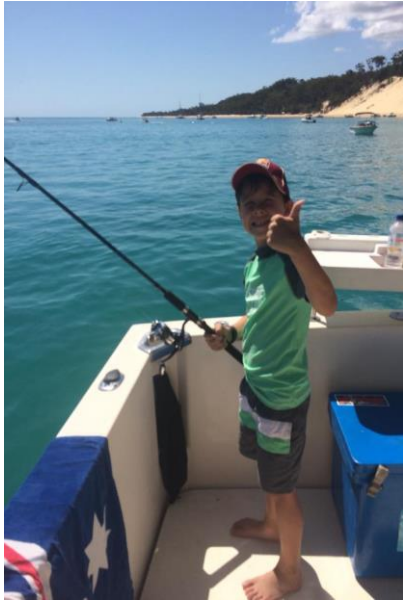

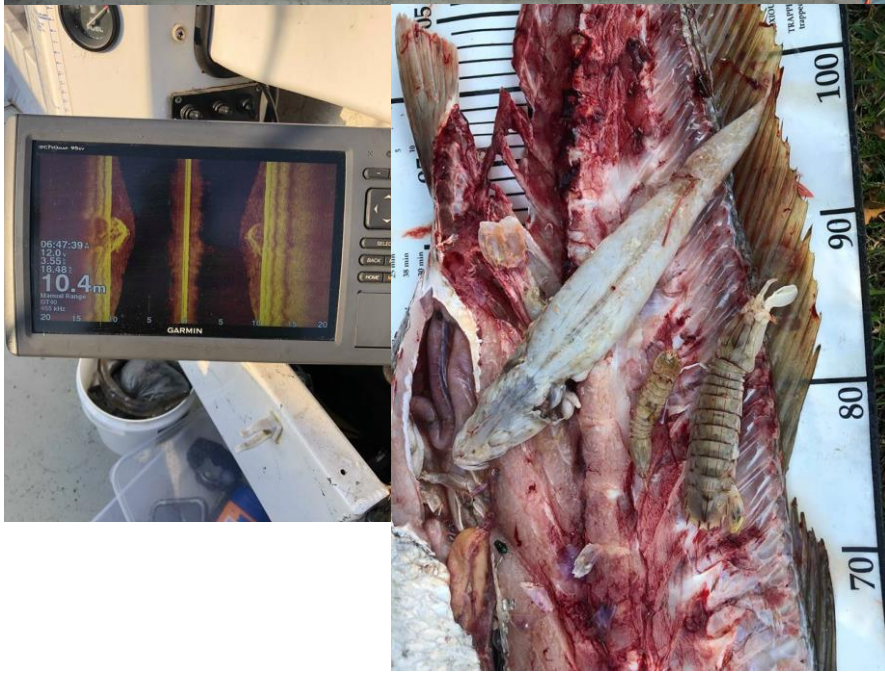

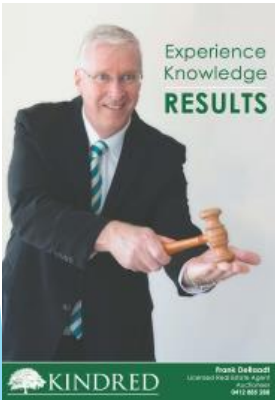
