

#### Chairman's Report

It was great to have a get together at our last weigh-in Sunday afternoon. Good to catch up and tell a few tales. Even better to see some fish weighed in with young Jesse Harbourne taking out the inshore species with a good-sized Bream.

Hopefully our meetings will now continue. I look forward to seeing a good turnout at our next meeting on **Wednesday July 15**<sup>th</sup> at the Boat Club.

It looks like our planned Family Camping Weekend at Somerset Dam on the 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> August will be well attended with many members making bookings.

Unfortunately, the Cabins out there are booked out but there are still a few powered campsites available, just tell them you are with the RPGSC.

I am in the process of applying for a Moreton Bay Regional Council "Facilities Grant" to up-grade our Barbeque area by erecting a fixed metal roof instead of the shade sails. It will be a gabled roof carport structure that will enable us to use of this area even if the weather is bad. We will have it wired with lights and power and add roll down clears to the necessary sides to keep rain out. Although we have the option of the deck, sometimes this is inconvenient for MBBC. The MBBC Board of Directors have given their approval as this will be a great asset for the club. I have a couple of quotes already; we just need the Council funds.

Membership renewals are coming due and we have the new 2020 -2021 forms available. Two members have renewed already, it would be great to see as many members as possible renew early. #### Club Captain's report

Looking forward to seeing our fishing members and guests back for a chat at the next fishing meeting. Reminder: first Meeting is at the club at 7pm on the 15<sup>th</sup> July, our AGM 12<sup>th</sup> August (TBC) and our Presentation Trophy night on the 22<sup>nd</sup> August.

What has occurred during Covid 19 and recently: Changes for recreational fishers include:

- •a new annual seasonal closure for snapper and pearl perch from 15 July to 15 August
- •increasing the size limit of pearl perch from 35cm to 38cm
- •removing extended charter catch limits for snapper and pearl perch
- •new boat limits for mud crab, prawns, snapper, black jewfish, barramundi, Spanish mackerel, shark, tropical rock lobster and sea cucumber, which hold the operator of the boat responsible for ensuring no more than 2 times the possession limit of these 9 priority black-market species is on board at any time (the boat limit does not apply to charter boats)
- •general possession limit of 20 fish for species without a prescribed possession limit, excluding some bait species
- •reducing the mud crab possession limit from 10 to 7
- •reducing pipi and mollusc limits from 50 to 30.

Let's get out there and catch more. See you at the meeting everyone



To win the money for the monthly nominated fish inshore or offshore species, simply weigh in the heaviest **Amberjack** or **Tailor**. All fish weighed, regardless of whether they are in for the 'fish of the month' must be labelled with the angler's name and line class. To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded on the day so you must be there. Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on **Friday 17**th **July** finishing on **Sunday 19**th **July** at 3.30pm.

There may be some restrictions still in place regarding numbers inside venues but hopefully many current restrictions will be relaxed by October. The weekend agenda will include a meet 'n' greet, Fishing competition, presentation dinner and AGM. My plan at this stage to get up there a few days prior to check out the fishing and some of the sights. Apparently, the Mangrove Jacks and Barramundi can really fish up at this time of the year. I know of members from Ipswich, Maryborough, Sunshine and Kingaroy fishing clubs to name a few, will be making the trip. There was also some Redclaw around. The campers next to us score half a bucket of Redclaw each night using rockmelon for bait.








## TACKLE BOX July 2020

Can anyone guess what Jon Eagle & Brad Clayton are doing in 600m of water? Hint: it involved a brick and a nomination for the toilet seat award!










#### Weightmaster's report




