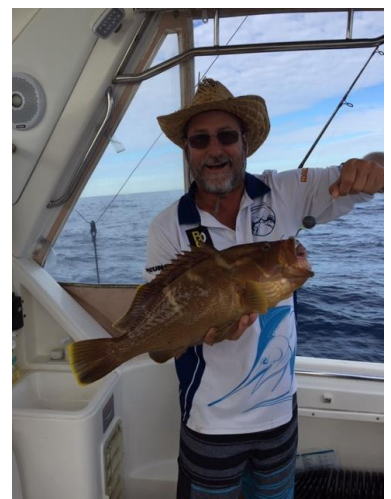
Our presentation Night is going to held on 10 August this year so please save the date in your diaries. It is always a fun night.

To win the money for the monthly nominated fish inshore or offshore species, simply weigh in the heaviest **Longtail Tuna** or **Bream**. All fish weighed, regardless of whether they are in for the 'fish of the month' must be labelled with the angler's name and line class. To receive double club points, fish must be tagged or caught on the Club Weekend only and the cards correctly completed and handed in or fish weighed in at M.B.B.C. from 3.30pm to 4.30pm on the Sunday. Prizes for the heaviest 'fish of the month' will be awarded on the day. Remember, club fishing weekend starts on midnight on **Friday 14th June** finishing on **Sunday 16th June** at 3.30-4.30pm.

A.N.S.A QLD Report

The 2019 STATEWIDE SPECIES CHALLENGE has been run and won on the June long weekend. If you visit the website you can see who caught what, it is very interesting.

The winners are:

Individual Male – Chris Bache from Cairns SFC with 29 species

Individual Female – Helen Johnson from Bundaberg SFC with 20 species

Individual Junior – Blake Manthey from Kingaroy SFC with 18 species

Individual Sub Junior – Toby Hulme from Kingaroy SFC with 10 species

The individual winners all received a prize. All anglers that registered a fish on the website went into a random draw for \$250 fishing tackle voucher. The lucky angler was Paul Hulme from Kingaroy SFC.

I have to say it's a bit disappointing that not many members from our club bothered to have a fish. ANSA QLD is always looking for feedback, so if you can share your reason for not getting involved or you can suggest any possible improvements to entice participation, please let me know and I can pass them on. The Bundy and Kingaroy clubs had the most participants.

Later this year, 4th to 7th of October, the Sunshine Coast SFC is hosting the Annual Fishing Festival and AGM. Registration opens very soon so keep checking the website. The Qld State Titles will be run in conjunction with the festival and our club will have an opportunity to nominate a senior and a junior angler to compete in the State Titles against nominees from all the other ANSA clubs. This will be done at the end of our fishing year. The concept of the State Titles is to find the best angler. This will be done over 3 fishing sessions over two days. ANSAs plan is then to work with the other states to organize and promote the Nation titles in the future. This means someone from our club could potentially be the Australian Champion.

Currently we are 5th on the table for Champion club with 38 species, which is more than last year. Kingaroy SFC have moved into 3rd position. They had quite a few members head up to Harvey Bay for the Species challenge which really bolstered their total.

Later in the year I am thinking of doing a trip up to Monduran Dam (near Gin Gin, about 4 hr drive) to chase a Barra if anyone wants to tag along. Probably around November when the northerlies start to kick in. The lead up to the full moon is often the best and the moon will make pleasant night fishing. The dam has been fishing well this year with lots of fish in the 60 to 80 cm long class. They grow very fast and fat in Monduran. If it turns out that Awoonga (90 minutes up the road) is fishing better, then that might be a better option. Personally, I have a soft spot for Monduran Dam because I got a 1220 fish there in 2011 before the big floods.

Side note - Dan McCoy caught a Bass last year at Lake Somerset which has now been ratified as an Australian record. It weighed in at 4.455kg (9.82 pounds) and was released to fight another day.

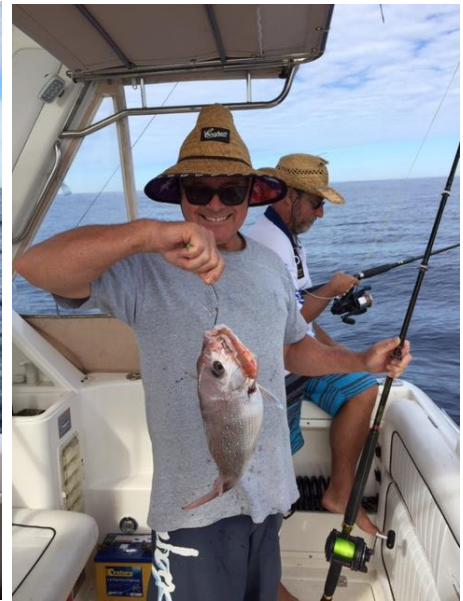
I still have a 3 tag guns and 2 dart applicators if someone needs them. \$20 each.
