G'day all, as I am writing this Mick and myself are in the car heading north to Hinchinbrook for the ANSA AGM and Sportsfishing festival.

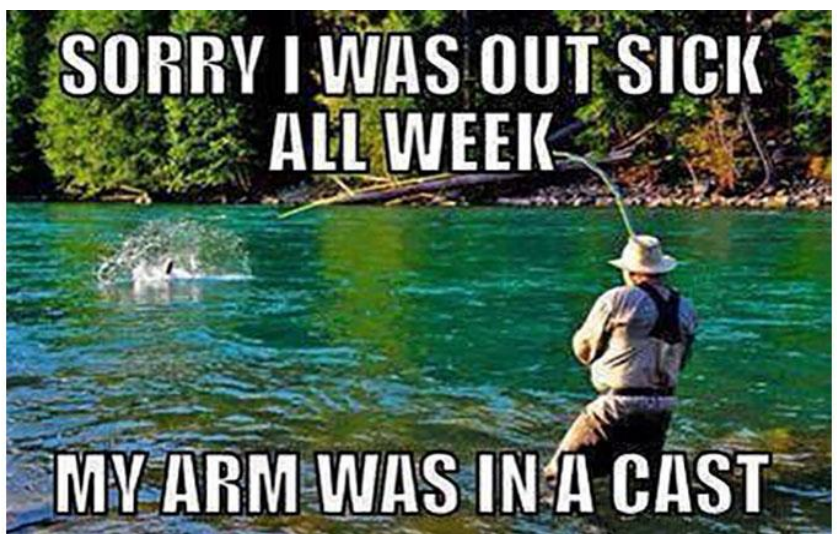
Thanks to Greg Skinner for the loan of the boat, will have some stories and pics for next Tackle Box.

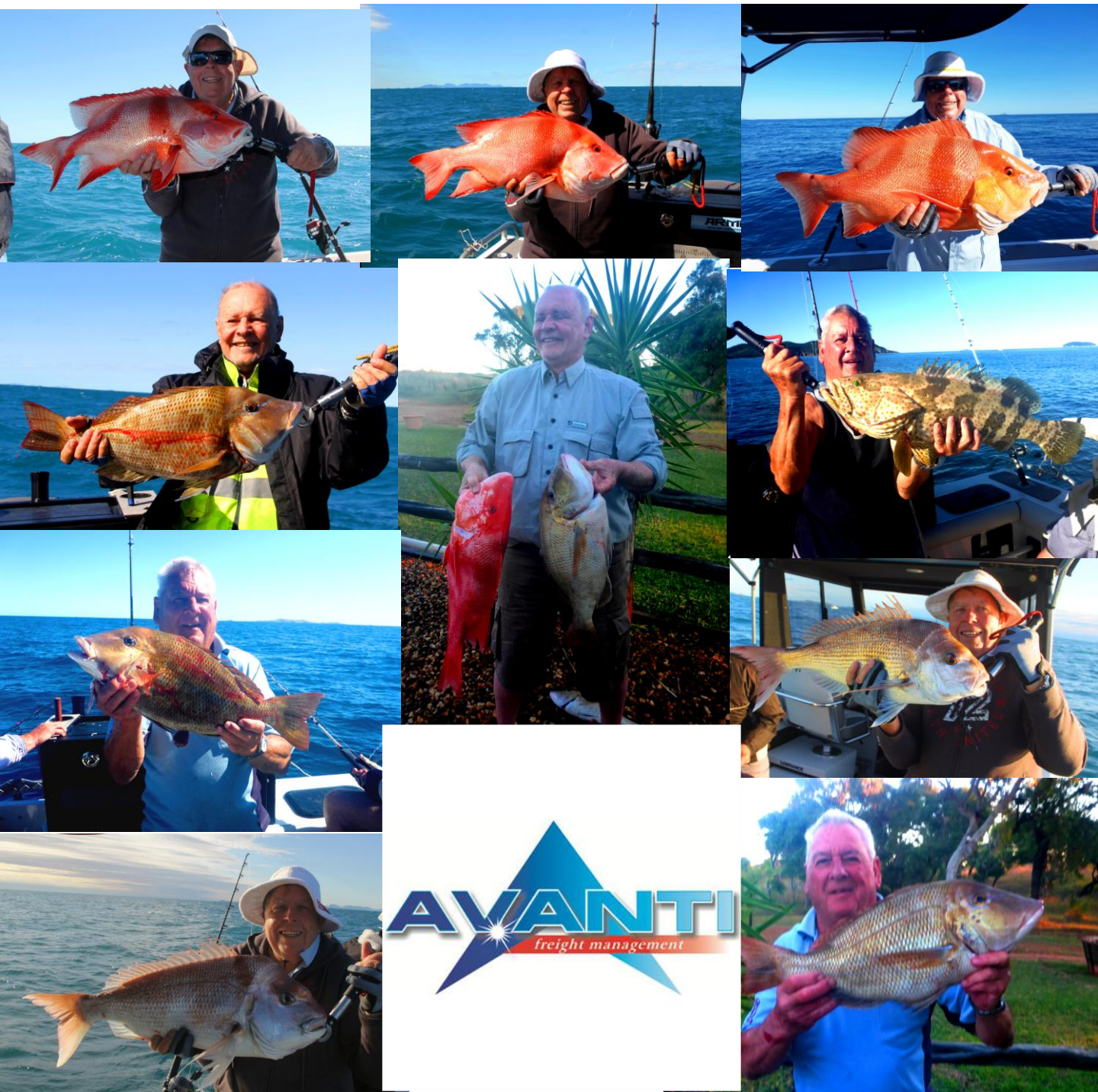

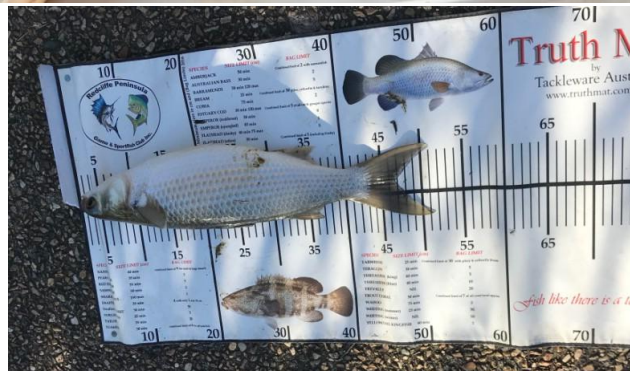

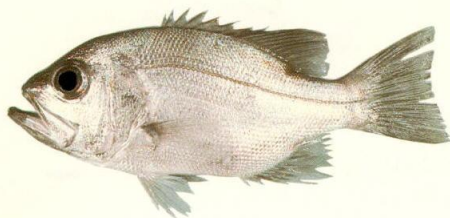
