Below is a communication from ANSA National:-

IGFA has recently announced that 2 new species will be added to its eligibility listing for World Records. The 2 new eligible species are -

*White (Silver) Trevally (**Pseudocaranx dentex**) and Murray Cod (**Maccullochella peelii**)*

ANSA already has White (Silver) Trevally included as an eligible "Game" species under its eligible sportfish species listing so there is no need to make any changes to the ANSA rule book.

Murray Cod are also already listed as eligible sportfish species for ANSA but we have not classed the species as a game fish. The National executive has considered the merits or otherwise of upgrading the status of Murray Cod to that of a "Game Fish" species but has decided not to change the current sportfish status.

This decision does not affect ANSA members capacity to claim an IGFA World record for a Murray Cod.

RECORDER REPORT - May

Hi members,

The points in the tackle box will not be published for the rest of the fishing year. This is to keep anglers guessing for presentation night. Makes the night a bit more exciting. But I can report that, I have been receiving a few Capture sheets, mostly for sportfishing.

I am surprised I haven't received more capture sheets considering the fantastic fishing on offer in the last few months. Fish are biting well at times depending on what you like to chase and how good you are. The summer gamefishing season has been a disaster, but the Autumn offshore fishing has improved going by reports from dedicated anglers. Hopefully the weather continues to improve because the Blue Marlin fishing, wide off the Cape can be pretty good in May.

Without giving away too much, some of the biggest improvers in the club points for under 7m boats is "Guinness", skippered by Frank Downey and "Lifes Good", skippered by Noel Day. Keep up the good work lads.

I can also say, there are a few more ladies in the points too for Sportfishing.

If you need to know how points are allocated throughout the year, the fishing rules are on the RPGSC website. This is where you find weight points formulas and tag points. Points are assigned depending on line class. This why we promote IGFA rated lines and pre-tested lines and similar.

Please remember that members can weigh their fish themselves outside of club weekends. You will need to have your scales checked out by the weighmaster for accuracy. You can get this do at the club weigh-in each month. Complete a capture sheet and send it to the recorder along with pictures. If the fish is a record, you will need to weigh it on official registered scales.

We now have a Capture sheet to the website. This would be useful for members don't have access to an official capture book available. You will find it a www.rpgfc.com.au under the Club points tab.

A note to all members – If you don't know what line class you're using or what fishing rules you are fishing under. Then you're probably not fishing to the rules and therefore, should not submit a capture sheet. Take the time to learn and understand the rules.

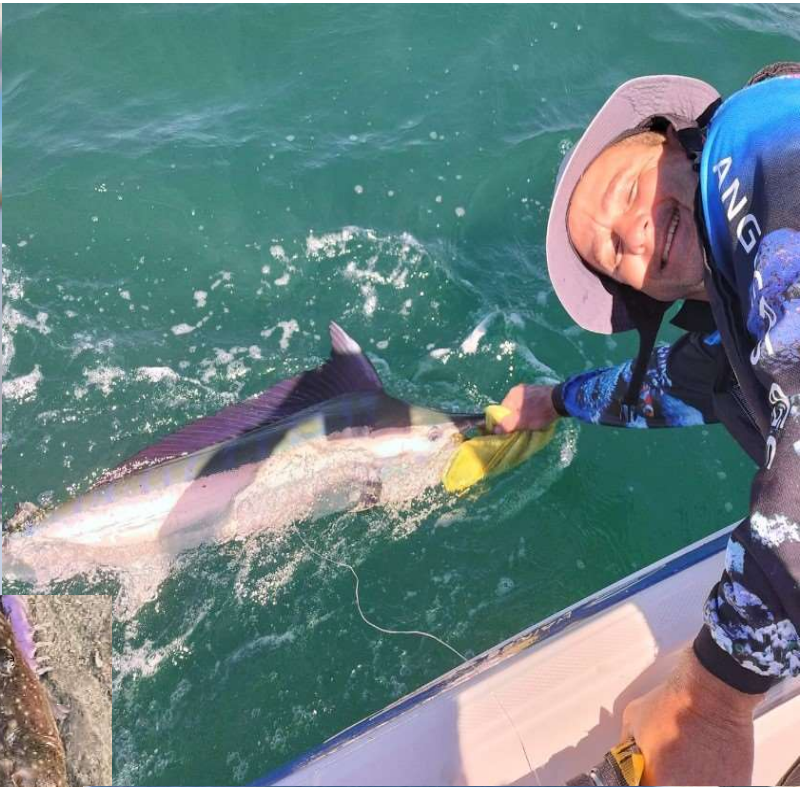

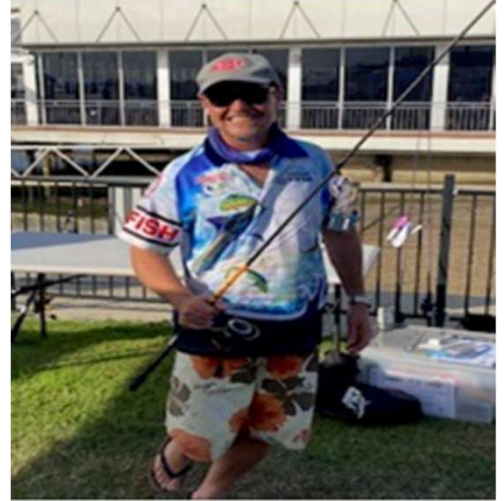
